WORKSHOP ON APPLIANCE THERAPY AND DIAGNOSTIC
INSTRUMENTS FOR SLEEP DISORDERED BREATHING

About the Speaker: Dr. W. Keith Thornton is a third generation dentist who practiced in restorative dentistry in Dallas, Texas for 37 years. In addition to practicing general dentistry, Dr. Thornton focused on the treatment of temporomandibular disorders (TMD) and was a leader in the use of splint therapy for the treatment of jaw joint pain. Using his knowledge and background in TMD management, Dr. Thornton invented the Thornton Adjustable Positioner (TAP®) for sleep disordered breathing in 1994. Today, he holds approximately 36 patents on this technology.

Dr. Thornton taught for 25 years at the Pankey Institute for Advanced Dental Education. He is a member of the Restorative Academy of Dentistry and is part of the Orthodontic Department faculty at the Texas A&M Baylor College of Dentistry. Dr. Thornton is a board certified Diplomate of the American Board of Dental Sleep Medicine (ABDSM) and a member of the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine. Today, Dr. Thornton continues to invent, teach, and advance the field of sleep medicine. On his days off, he likes to spend time driving his tractor.



About the Course: Integrating a new therapy into a dental practice can sometimes be an overwhelming undertaking. Demand for treatment of snoring and sleep apnea is increasing exponentially, yet the dentist is confronted with what seems to be a great barrier due to the serious consequences and medical nature of the condition.
